We produce high quality, great tasting craft beers and are active participants in the vibrant beer culture that exists in Fort Collins and throughout Colorado. As with our beers, we strive to achieve balance in work, life and community.

The Packaging Line Team Member must be available to work Mondays from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. and will be primarily responsible for working on our team that packages our beers into cans, bottles and kegs. This position will also contribute to the operation, cleaning, and maintenance of equipment involved in beer packaging and production processes by following established procedures. This is an important learning and entry point into the production side of craft brewing and we expect a team member who is eager to learn and contribute. Key responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Preparation of beer for packaging
- Packaging of beer cans and kegs while maintaining beer quality
- Cleaning and sanitization of all beer contact surfaces and equipment
- Operating equipment safely and following all workplace safety procedures
- Monitoring of essential facility equipment related to packaging (air compressor, etc.)
- Performing minor maintenance tasks on production equipment and alerting brewers when repairs are needed that are outside of your scope
- General production area and warehouse cleaning
- Forklift operation (we will provide training)

All of our employees are expected to be contributing members of our small team and as such, you will need to be ready and willing to perform the following:

- Troubleshooting equipment problems
- Providing a clean and safe production and storage environment
- Complying with all company policies
- Assisting in any other business-related needs
- Frequent and open communication with brewery management
- Ability to safely operate a forklift with appropriate certification. The company will support training and certification as required.
- Safety. We are committed to safety in all aspects of production and delivery and all employees are expected to be as well. This position requires the ability to repeatedly and safely lift and move full cases weighing up to 55 pounds, moving kegs weighing 165 pounds, handle and properly store, stock and stack of all of our products, scale ladders, and work at heights.
- We expect all Horse & Dragon employees to be positive representatives of the brand, the company and themselves both inside and outside of work.
